## **ESSENTIAL AND IMPORTANT DUTIES:**

- Serve as a positive role model to the players and parents
- Teach fundamentals, playing rules, strategies and playing tactics
- Condition athletes appropriately for activities requiring endurance, strength and agility
- Preside over team activities including all scheduled team practices and games
- Teach sportsmanship, cooperation, work ethic and responsibility to one's team
- Monitor players personal conduct during games
- Manage equipment

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** Ability to work well with children of various ages; basic knowledge of the sport you would like to coach; willingness to learn and follow District rules and guidelines regarding youth sports; prior coaching experience is helpful but not required. Education/experience: Any combination of education and experience that would likely provide the required knowledge and skills is qualifying. A typical way to obtain the knowledge and skills would be:

• Previous experience in coaching children in some type of sport

• Formal or informal education or training which ensures the ability to read and write at a level necessary for successful coaching performance
