AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY OF TAXES FOR THE FOSS PARK DISTRICT, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2021 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2022

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS (THE "BOARD") OF THE FOSS PARK DISTRICT (THE "DISTRICT"), LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1

The following sum or sums of money, or so much thereof as shall be authorized by law, as heretofore appropriated for corporate purposes to be collected from the taxes to be levied for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2021 and ending April 30, 2022, be and the same are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Foss Park District, Lake County, Illinois as the same is assessed and equalized for State and County purposes of the said current year.

Section 2

That the purposes, for which said amounts were hereto appropriated, are now hereby levied respectively as follows:

If any item or portion thereof of this Tax Levy Ordinance is for any reason held invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of such item of the remaining portion of this ordinance.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effective immediately upon its passage.




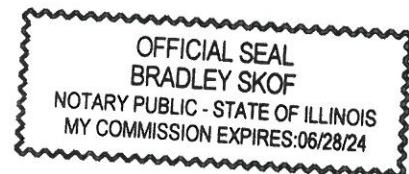

NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX INCREASE FOR FOSS PARK DISTRICT

- I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax increase for Foss Park District for 2021 will be held on Wednesday December 15, 2021 at 5:30PM via a Zoom link.

- II. The corporate and special purpose taxes extended for 2020 were \$1,501,969.

The proposed corporate and special purpose taxes to be levied for 2021 are \$1,687,500. This represents a 12.35% increase over the previous year.

- III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2020 were \$391,216.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2021 are \$396,000. This represents a 1.22% increase over the previous year.

- IV. The total property taxes extended for 2020 were \$1,893,185. The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2021 are \$2,083,500. This represents a 10.05% increase over the previous year.
