General Rules for Room Rentals:

• Alcohol consumption is only permitted at our golf course facilities.

No items can be stored at the facility before or after contracted rental time.

• Damage to the facility will result in the loss of the rental deposit.

Reservations must be made at least two weeks prior to the rental date, youth parties 1 month.
Contracted hours must include decorating and clean up hours.

• Failure to abide by the rental contract may result in deposit loss or shut down of the rental. Time lost will not be reimbursed.

 \circ Rental deposits are return 7-10 working days after the rental as long as all contract rules have been adhered to.
