#### **General Rules for Room Rentals:**

- Alcohol consumption is only permitted at our golf course facilities
- Smoking is not permitted in any indoor facility.
- No items can be stored at the facility before or after contracted rental time.
- At all indoor rentals, a supervisor is present throughout the length of the rental.
- Damage to the facility will result in the loss of the rental deposit.
- Reservations must be made at least two weeks prior to the rental date, youth parties 1 month.
- Contracted hours must include decorating and clean up hours.
- Failure to abide by the rental contract may result in deposit loss or shut down of the rental. Time lost will not be reimbursed.
- Rental deposits are return 7-10 working days after the rental as long as all contract rules have been adhered to.
- Each rental facility has additional rules and regulations.




