- **Parade Line-Up Crew** – 7:30 AM to 10:30 AM

- **Set-Up Crew** – 7:30 AM to 9:00 AM
Help distribute tables and chairs to tents throughout the park (must be able to lift)
- **Children's Zone Helpers** – Noon to 7:00 PM (*shifts available*)
Support Family First Center's *Unity in Community* by running games and monitoring activities for kids.
- **Wristband Distribution Support** – 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM
Assist police and security by issuing wristbands to minors (under 18) who are accompanied by a responsible adult (25+). No unaccompanied minors allowed after dark.
